

Beckley Motor Speedway: Enduro Class 2022 Rules

The following specifications are prepared for Beckley Motor Speedway for the Enduro class rules. No expressed or implied warranty shall result from the publication of, or compliance with these rules. They are intended as a guide and are no way a guarantee against injury or death to participants, spectators, or others. Serious injury or death can occur. Racing is a dangerous sport and you do so at your own risk.

These specs are set by Beckley Motor Speedway and may be updated or amended at any with/without notice. If it's not stated in the rules, it's now allowed.

Car and Body:

- A) Any standard passenger vehicle (cars, mini vans, small trucks: ex. S10, Ford Ranger, Dodge Dakota, Toyota Tacoma). AWD and 4x4 must be disabled. No aftermarket air flow systems. If the car does not meet the spirit or nature of the class, the technical inspector has every right to turn the vehicle/car away.
- B) Engines and drivetrain must remain stock for that vehicle/car.
- C) Suspension must remain stock for that vehicle/car. No racing parts or shocks allowed.
- D) For the body, all glass and trim must be removed. No mirrors are allowed. Doors must be secured to where you cannot open it. The car structure may not be gutted including deck lids or hoods. Interior, rear seats, headliners, and door panels must be removed. Bumpers are to remain in the stock location. If the bumper is missing, the shocks or frame horns are not to be placed outside the body line. The car cannot have a fabricated bumper or extra supports welded in. You may use another vehicle's/car's bumper if you damage the original. Front windshields may be left in the vehicle/car. All glass pieces must be removed from the doors and inside of the car including back glass/windshield. ***NO TOLERANCE*** Air bags must be removed or disabled.
- E) Batteries may be moved for easy access and safety but must be secured and placed in some sort of protective box for safety of the driver and others.
- F) If the vehicle has no windshield, the vehicle must have 4 window bars spaced evenly over the windshield, and a screen covering over the driver is required.
- G) Sunroofs and T-Tops must have a solid covering.

Tires and Wheels:

- A) Only DOT tires are allowed. No rough treads, no racing DOTs. Wheels must be stock type, stock location, and no racing wheels. ***All wheel weights and hub caps must be removed.*** Donut tires are allowed on the rear of the vehicle/car.

Safety:

- A) Fire extinguisher and a 3-inch hole in the hood for fire access are mandatory. Helmets must be DOT approved or snell rated. ***Fire Suits, racing boots, and gloves are required.*** All other racing equipment is strongly recommended: racing belts, racing seats, and roll cages. Fuel cells and fuel lines inside the vehicle/car must be covered. ***Serious injury or death can occur if the proper safety precautions are not taken.***
